RE: Byrnes Mill Road

Mr. Banks,

We've met on a number of occasions, most recently at the Hwy W/MM Task Force Meetings.

Apparently due to a mix-up in communications, a portion of Byrnes Mill Road in our city, and two portions in unincorporated County were recently labeled in error as "Lower Byrnes Mill Road."

The topic has been discussed at our Board of Alderman meetings, and neighbors and I have discussed it with representatives of the County, residents living on the road, a representative of 9-1-1, a representative of MoDot, and others.

As a result, on behalf of our city, I am requesting that the County make no further changes to labeling this road for at least six months while a group of citizens "touch base" with all residents living on the road, and all agencies involved, (police, fire, 9-1-1, city administration, post office, etc.) to come up with a recommendation.

Everyone I've spoken with to date thinks the best naming scheme would be to have the entire road (from PP to Gravois Road) become "Byrnes Mill Road" (map enclosed) but we will not recommend this until written agreements have been acquired.

Thank you for your consideration of this request.
