

Byrnes Mill Fall Festival Rules

Event Information:

Saturday, October 05, 2024

10:00 am – 5:00pm *see below for vendor specific times*

Location: Byrnes Mill City Park - off Hwy 30 on Lower Byrnes Mill Road, between House Springs and High Ridge.

What can be sold?

Crafts: We encourage that crafts be handmade but will make exceptions on a case by case basis.

Value added agricultural products: This category includes products made of raw agricultural products that have been processed. Examples are: jams, jellies, spice mixes, salsas, sauces, oils, vinegars, baked goods, molasses, cider, nuts. Sellers must abide by all federal, state and local health department regulations. The most important are labeling rules. Edible products must have all ingredients listed, in order, from most to least. Name and address of the seller must also be listed. Some products may require a Jefferson County Health Department permit. Examples would be cheese products, any acidic product.

Raw agricultural animal products: This category includes fruits, vegetables, grains, herbs, flowers, bedding plants and potted plants. All must be sold in the whole form, not cut open.

Meat and other animal products: This category includes meats, poultry, milk, cheese, eggs, farm-raised fish, honey, wool, leather. Sellers must abide by all federal, state and local health department regulations. Jefferson County health permits may be required.

Educational and Community Activities: Space will be made available for non-profit community groups free of charge.

Space: \$20.00 to be paid using the online payment portal at time of submitting your application.

Reservations: Applications will be dated and spaces awarded on a first come, first serve basis.

All edible products must be covered with a canopy. All canopies must be secured to the ground.

Set-up: Festival starts at 10:00am. Vendors may arrive and begin setting up at 8:30am.

Take-down: Please do not start taking down your booth(s) before 5:00pm at the end of the Festival.

Vendor Guidelines

- Each vendor's location will be assigned to them the day of the event. We will do our best to assure all vendors have a great space, but specific locations can't be guaranteed.
- Only one vehicle is allowed to be parked at each vendor space (no trailers).
- No vehicles can enter or leave the event from 10am to 4pm. Once your vehicle is parked near your vendor space, it must remain there. If you wish to unload and move your vehicle to the other side of the park in the lower area, please do so before 9:30am.
- Vendors can arrive as early as 8:30am to begin setting up their booth but must arrive no later than 9:30am.
- There is no electricity provided at the vendor space locations.
- Please bring your own chairs and canopy tent.
- All canopy tents must be anchored into the ground and must not create a trip hazard.
- Each vendor is entirely responsible for their own property, exhibits, merchandise, and the exhibit space allotted and shall be liable for any loss, damage, or clean up to the premises.
- Please consider the vendor area will be in a grassy location, when determining the vehicle you'll be using.

Day of Event

- Arrive as early as 8:30am to begin unloading and staging your area.
- Upon arrival, check in at the gravel driveway near the pavilion.
